Faculty are available to assist students during their posted office hours.

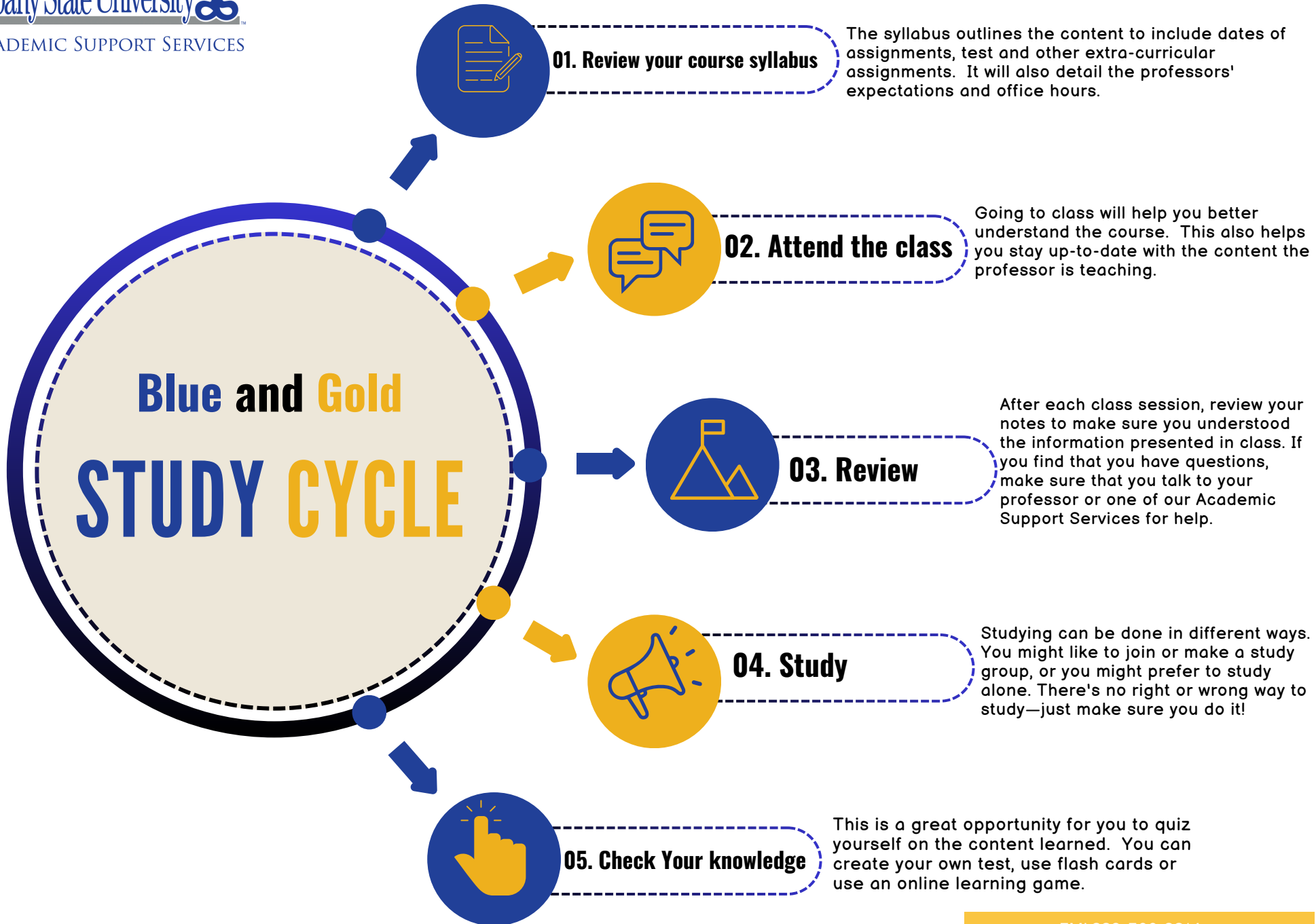


ONLINE TUTORING
